COMING SOON....Town of Merrimac Drinking Water Testing Program

When is the last time you had your drinking water tested? If it has been over a year, you have waited too long. In July Town of Merrimac residents will have the opportunity to test their drinking water through a program coordinated by the Town of Merrimac, the University of Wisconsin-Extension and the Sauk County Conservation, Planning and Zoning Department. The goal of the program is to make it as easy as possible for residents to learn about their drinking water quality and possible remedies if there is an issue.

In June you will receive a blue flyer in the mail describing the three drinking water testing packages and their purchase prices. If you are interested in participating in this voluntary program you will be able to purchase the testing bottles at the Merrimac Town Hall. You can pick up your test results and learn more about protecting your drinking water quality at educational program at the River Arts Center on August 22nd from 7PM to 8:30PM.
