The board considered adjournment until Saturday, August 7, 2010 at 9am as it anticipated the assessment roll will be complete. Motion by Peetz to adjourn, second by Frosch. Motion passed. The assessor will conduct the Open Book on Saturday, July 10, 2010 from 9am until 11am.

MINUTES OF THE TOWN BOARD MEETING

Wednesday, June 02, 2010

Present were Steve Peetz, Chair, Supervisor John Gaedke, Supervisor Terry Frosch, and Tim McCumber, Town Administrator & Clerk – Treasurer.

Peetz called the **TOWN BOARD MEETING** to order. McCumber confirmed the meeting had been properly noticed. The board considered approval of minutes of the town board meeting of May 5, 2010. Motion by Frosch to approve, second by Peetz. Motion passed. The board reviewed the financial reports and approval of bills. Motion by Peetz to approve, second Frosch. Motion passed. Under **PUBLIC COMMENT**, Laura Olah, Citizens for Safe Drinking Water at Badger (CSWAB) discussed an expansion of the contaminants near the Town of Sumpter and also asked the board to consider asking for conditions when the Army comes in to ask for expansion of the landfill. They are recommending to the Army that they test private wells, deeper groundwater monitoring wells at Inspiration Dr. and Kilpatrick Point Rd., She also said they are putting in materials that they were not approved for. Under **CORRESPONDENCE** a letter Cathy and Mark Prescott addressed to Idlewild Neighborhood regarding fireworks; Badger Army Ammunition Plant public comment period through June 26, 2010 related to disposal of property; a letter from the AIDS Network regarding the annual ACT 8 through Merrimac on July 29, 2010, and a letter from Badger Army Ammunition plant regarding the expansion of the existing landfill at Badger. Under **REPORTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES**, annexation law fix signed into law by Governor Doyle. Peetz reported the cleanup day went very well. Thank you to Terry and Saroya Frosch and Nadine Peetz for cleaning up the property and donating plants. There was no **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**. Under **NEW BUSINESS**, the board discussed possible action regarding a recommendation from the Planning & Zoning Commission to approve a for a Conditional Use Permit for an accessory structure greater than 24' x 30' x 14' on a residential property in the Agricultural District per Town Ordinance 5.03 (1)(a)(1) and 7.02(3)(b); Jerry Groth, applicant. E13891 Dan-Mar Ct., Merrimac, WI 53561; Tax Parcel 0944-00000. Peetz, Frosch. Motion passed. The board then considered a request for a fireworks permit to allow DAC Productions to display fireworks at Merry Mac's Campground on June 26, 2010. Pat Rehwinkel appeared noting that the program is the same as last year. Motion by Peetz to approve, second by Frosch. The board also considered action to consider the issuance of the following alcohol licenses: **CLASS "B" COMBINATION LICENSE**: Joseph P. Vittengl, Agent for Ski Enterprise Corporation of Wisconsin, Inc., d/b/a Devil's Head Resort and Convention Center; Jennifer Canterbury Risgaard, Agent for JMT Enterprises of Wisconsin, Inc., d/b/a The Old Schoolhouse Restaurant; Thane A. Newman, Agent for Newman Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Hillcrest on Lake Wisconsin; **CLASS "A" COMBINATION LICENSE**: Charlie C. Fuchs, d/b/a Lakeside Hardware; **CLASS "B" BEER LICENSE**: Merrimac Conservation Club; Merry Mac's Campground, LLC.; **CLASS "A" BEER LICENSE**: Moon Valley Resort, LLC.. McCumber reported the applications were all in order. A motion was made by Frosch, second by Peetz to approve.
