**NOTICE TO PERSONS WHO HAVE EXPRESSED AN INTEREST IN PLACING A
PIER OR A BOAT MOORING ON A PUBLIC ACCESS IN THE TOWN OF
MERRIMAC**

At the December 3, 2002 Town Board Meeting the board unanimously adopted a two year moratorium on any new pier permits in the Town of Merrimac.

This means that only those persons who have applied for and received permits in the past may apply for 2003 and 2004. Those persons may make no changes to their permit application, which is to say no new persons or boat lifts may be added to a pier permit application.

If someone no longer wants a boat lift or a pier no one else may apply for it.

Persons who currently own piers and hold permits do not have the authority to grant to another person the use of their pier for a boat lift. As the riparian owner of the public accesses the Town becomes the applicant to the DNR for the piers and only the Town has authority to determine who will be permitted to have a pier or boat lift on someone else's pier on a public access.
